

OFFICIAL RULES

NUMBER OF PLAYERS: Two

HOW TO PLAY:

- 1. The game is played on any table or desk top.
- 2. Players sit on opposite sides of the table.
- The object of the game is to advance the FIKI BASEBALL toward the opposite side of the table in an attempt to have the ball hang over the edge of the table without falling off.
- 4. An at-bat consists of three "swings" to advance the ball across the table (reference the photos below).
- 5. Each successive swing begins at the point where the ball came to rest.
- 6. To score a run the ball must hang over the edge of the opposite side of the table in three (3) swings or less or by successfully flicking the FIKI BASEBALL over the fence for a solo home run.

HOME-RUN FLICK

AN OUT IS RECORDED & AN AT BAT ENDS WHEN:

- 1. After three swings the FIKI BASEBALL fails to reach the opposite edge of the table. An out is recorded and the opponent begins an at bat where the ball came to rest.
- 2. If at any time the FIKI BASEBALL leaves the table as a result of a swing.

HOW TO SCORE:


- 1. As a result of a swing the FIKI BASEBALL hangs over the edge of the opposite side of the table without falling off. A run is scored.
- 2. As a result of a swing the FIKI BASEBALL leaves the table, The opponent is given the opportunity to flick the FIKI BASEBALL over the fence for a solo home run. Score one run.


THE GAME ENDS WHEN:

- 1. Either player reaches a pre-determined number of runs.
- 2. Nine (9) innings.



ASSEMBLY: See diagram below. Slide the bottom of the home run fence into the brackets located on the FIKI baseball field.
